

# Required 2010-2011 FAFSA Data

## 1. **Request a FAFSA Personal Identification Number (PIN)**

- The student and one parent must both request their own PIN.
- Request your PIN at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov)
- Most people are able to immediately receive and use their PIN, but some users have to wait several days. So it's best to request it early.
- Once you have your PIN, it is good forever. It never expires or changes.
- If a parent is also a student, the same PIN can be used for both parent and student roles.

## 2. **Student Data**

- Social Security Number. Be sure it is correct!
- Driver's license Number (if any)
- If you are not a U.S. Citizen, bring your Alien registration or permanent resident number

## 3. **Financial Data**

- Financial Data is required for the student.
- If you are dependent, it's also required for your parent(s).
- If you are married, it's also required for your spouse.
- Current combined cash, savings, and checking account balance
- 2009 Federal Income Tax Returns
  - IRS 1040 (2 page form), 1040A (2 page form), 1040 EZ (1 page form)
  - Foreign Tax Return
- 2009 W-2 Forms and other records of money earned
- 2009 Child Support Paid (*if applicable*)
- 2009 Untaxed Income (*if applicable*)
  - Veterans benefits (*if applicable*)
  - Child Support Received (*if applicable*)
  - Worker's Compensation Benefits (*if applicable*)
- Current business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond and other investment records (*if applicable*)
