## 2009-2010 Kathy and Jerry Wood Scholarship

**Qualifications:**

- Must graduate from an Anne Arundel County public high school
- Must graduate high school in 2009 or must have graduated high school before August 2006.
- Current Un-weighted high school GPA of at least 2.5
- U.S. citizen
- Show some financial need (Students do not have to be eligible for a Federal Pell Grant.)
- Must enroll full-time in an AACC degree or certificate program.

AACC will award at least one scholarship for each Anne Arundel County Public High School. Selected students will receive \$1500 for the fall semester and will also receive \$1500 for the spring semester after successfully completing at least 12 fall credits with a minimum 2.5 G.P.A. The Scholarship is renewable for the next academic year if the student maintains a 2.5 GPA and completes 27 credits.

**How to Apply:**

- Apply for admission to AACC. To apply online, go to [www.aacc.edu/admissions](http://www.aacc.edu/admissions)
- Return this completed application to the Financial Aid Office. We will begin reviewing applications and awarding scholarships on April 1<sup>st</sup>, and will continue to accept applications after April 1<sup>st</sup> until we have made all available awards for each AA County Public High School.
- Complete a 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Please apply online at [www.aacc.edu/aid](http://www.aacc.edu/aid). AACC's school code is **002058**. For this scholarship, we would like to receive your FAFSA results by April 1<sup>st</sup>. If you apply on-line, we will receive your results in 1 to 7 days. If you mail your FAFSA, we will receive your results in 3 to 4 weeks. (*If you also want to apply for state grants and scholarships, you must submit your FAFSA by March 1*). If you need help with the FAFSA, please contact the Financial Aid Office. We are here to help.

The Selection Committee will select the most competitive applicants based on academic achievements, potential, ability to contribute to the college community, and financial need.
