

COMMUNICATION ARTS Scholarships

Henry D. Burroughs Memorial - \$1,900

Applicants must be full-time students seeking a degree with a preference for communication arts; must demonstrate financial need; minimum 2.5 GPA.

*NOTE: All scholarship awards will be toward tuition for credit courses in spring semester 2010.
All scholarships may be split among deserving applicants.*

Selection criteria:

1. Educational objectives and background.
2. Artistic/design ability demonstrated in a portfolio of 5 – 10 works.
3. GPA, both overall, and in area specific courses.
4. A FASFA application is required to prove financial need.

Application procedure:

1. Submit an **application** to Prof. Drew Snyder by November 11, 2009.
2. A **portfolio** of 5 – 10 works that give the broadest view of your work as a student to be presented at the interview in November.
3. **FAFSA information** must be on file by November 4 (www.fafsa.ed.gov)
4. Selected applicants will have a 15 minute **interview** with members of the faculty to present and discuss their work, their educational and artistic experience, and their plans for the future.
5. Applications may also include letters **of recommendation**.
