



**The Presidential Scholarship:** is for first-year college students who enroll full time at Anne Arundel Community College to pursue a degree or certificate. The selected students will receive \$1500 for the fall semester and will also receive \$1500 for the spring semester after successfully completing at least 12 credits in the fall with a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. This scholarship is not renewable for additional years.

**Qualifications:**

- Current Senior at an Anne Arundel County Public High School
- Current unweighted high school GPA of at least 3.0
- Must have Completed SAT's
- Anne Arundel County resident

**The Kathy and Jerry Wood Scholarship:** is for first-year college students who will be enrolling full time at Anne Arundel Community College to pursue a degree or certificate. The selected students will receive \$1500 for the fall semester and will also receive \$1500 for the spring semester after successfully completing at least 12 fall credits with a minimum 2.5 G.P.A. The Scholarship is renewable for the next academic year if the student maintains a 2.5 GPA and completes 27 credits.

**Qualifications:**

- Current Senior at an Anne Arundel County public high school or you must have graduated from an Anne Arundel County public high school before August 2005.
- Unweighted high school GPA of at least 2.5
- U.S. citizen
- Show financial need (Students do not need to be Pell Grant eligible to be considered for this scholarship.)

**The August (Gus) and Marjorie Berlitz Endowed Scholarship:** was established in honor of Gus Berlitz by his wife, Marjorie Berlitz.

**Qualifications:**

- The full-time student must have a 3.5 or higher GPA, be a resident of AA county, a U.S. citizen and demonstrate financial need.

**The James L. Dollar Humanities Scholarship:** was established to honor Professor Dollar's lifelong interest in learning, the creative exploration of ideas, and his commitment to providing a pathway to success grounded in academic achievement.

**Qualifications:**

- The scholarship was established to provide money to supplement or augment the expenses of a student with a minimum 3.0 GPA who is enrolled in Arts & Sciences, Fine Arts, or Liberal Arts or the Honors program.
- The student must be a county resident and demonstrate financial need.
