This transfer guide is intended for students pursuing an Associate of Applied Science in Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice with an Area of Concentration in Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice at Anne Arundel Community College who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice (Concentrations: Social Justice, Community Based Corrections or Forensic Science) at Bowie State University. This transfer guide demonstrates how a student can meet both requirements for the associate and bachelor degrees.

SAVINGS:

Students can save up to **\$8,584.00** by completing their associate degree at Anne Arundel Community College, and then finish up bachelor degree requirements at Bowie State University {Based on tuition and fee costs 2022-23}.

BOWIE NOTES:

Students can transfer a maximum of 65 credits from AACC.

Students will substitute the second program elective (CJS) course requirement for HIS-214 at AACC.
