*It is suggested that students complete the AACC requirement using the option of a 6 credit, two-course sequence (ENG 111: Composition and Introduction to Literature 1 and ENG 112: Composition and Introduction to Literature 2 or ENG 115: Composition and Introduction to Literature for Non-native Speakers 1 and ENG 116: Composition and Introduction to Literature for Non-native Speakers 2 or ENG 121: Composition and Literature and ENG 207: Writing for Professionals) in order to fulfill the 6 credit EC Written English Requirement.

**The BIO 231: Human Biology 1 and BIO 232: Human Biology 2 sequence or BIO 233: Anatomy and Physiology 1 and BIO 234: Anatomy and Physiology 2 sequence with a grade of C or better is an option if students prefer to take them in lieu of passion BIO 230 with a grade of C or better.

***Courses would be classified as Health Sciences electives, but exceeds the maximum allowable 32 credits in this area.
