This transfer guide is intended for students pursuing an Associate of Applied Science in Radiologic Technology at Anne Arundel Community College who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences at Southern New Hampshire University. This transfer guide demonstrates how a student can meet both requirements for the associate and bachelor degrees.

### **SAVINGS:**

Students can save up to \$8,720.00 by completing their associate degree at Anne Arundel Community College and then finishing up at Southern New Hampshire University {Based on tuition costs 2019-20}

AACC graduates are eligible for a 10% tuition reduction.

### **NOTES:**

Students must earn a grade of C- or better for coursework to transfer.
