

FOREIGN MEDICAL GRADUATES AND INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

All foreign educated applicants must have transcripts of **all** higher education institutions attended evaluated by World Education Services (WES) at www.wes.org or Educational Credential Evaluators (ECE) at www.ece.org or the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (AACRAO) at www.aacrao.org/credential/individual.htm prior to evaluation by Anne Arundel Community College. In order for prerequisite courses to be evaluated and transferred in as meeting the AACC course equivalency, **all** foreign transcripts must be evaluated by one of these organizations listed above. No other evaluation services will be accepted. Please be advised that this process may take several months and must be completed by the application deadline. AACC requires a course-by-course evaluation in order for coursework to be considered for transfer.

An official evaluation must be sent directly from one of the above listed organizations to CASPA and mailed with the Physician Assistant Program Supplemental Application to:

All foreign-educated applicants must do one of the following:

- A. Successfully pass the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a minimum score of **600** on the paper based test or **100** on the Internet-based test by September 1, 2009. Please note: TOEFL scores are only valid for two years.

Anne Arundel Community College's code for TOEFL is 5019. An official copy of the TOEFL results must be sent to:

OR

- B. Applicants who have successfully completed college level English equivalent to Anne Arundel Community College's ENG 111 / 115 and ENG 112/ 116, or ENG 121 with a grade of "C" or higher are not required to take the TOEFL.

OR

- C. Applicants who have earned a bachelors degree or higher from a nationally recognized institution in the United States are not required to take the TOEFL.

GPA

CASPA does not compute GPA from WES, ACCRAO, and ECE evaluations. Therefore, AACC will manually calculate the GPA from these documents.
