



The College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) is a nationally recognized credit by exam program. CLEP tests are accepted at more than 2,800 colleges worldwide. CLEP tests are considered transfer credits at AACC.

Q & A ON CLEP EXAMS

How do I register for the exam?

Complete the CLEP application on the back of this brochure. Submit it to the Academic Support Center in the Student Union Room 240. A fee of \$30 goes to AACC and a fee of \$77 goes to Educational Testing Service (ETS). Pay the \$30 fee by check or money order payable to AACC or by credit or debit card. This fee must accompany your CLEP application. On the day of testing, pay the \$77 fee by credit card or by check payable to Educational Testing Service (ETS).

How will I know my scores?

The tests are administered online. You will receive your scores immediately.

How are CLEP exams scored and what score do I need to achieve credit?

Every correct answer is computed as one point. These points are totaled and converted into scaled scores. These scores range from 20-80. A scaled score of 50 is the passing score for each exam at AACC.

Where do I take the test?

Both the Arnold Testing Center(Sun240) or the Amil Testing Center(Amil112) offer CLEP exams

If I fail to get a passing score, can I take the exam again?

Yes. You may take the same CLEP test again after a six-month waiting period.

How can I prepare?

A suggested list of references, along with sample questions, is in the "CLEP Handbook" available at the Truxal Library reference desk. You may also want to see the College Board resources at <http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/lep/about.html>.

Are testing accommodations provided for students with disabilities?

Yes. Students with disabilities must provide written documentation to **Counseling, Advising and Retention Services (410-777-2306)** and must indicate the need for accommodations on their CLEP application form.

Please contact your AACC advisor prior to registering for a CLEP Exam. It is the student's responsibility to verify that the CLEP exam is accepted at any other College or University to which the student is planning to transfer.

Payment:

Please pay \$30 per test by check made out to AACC or by credit or debit card. The college accepts MasterCard, Visa, Discover and American Express cards.

Pay the remaining \$77 testing fee to Educational Testing Service by either check or credit card (NO CASH) on the day of testing. ETS accepts MasterCard, Visa, Discover, JCB or American Express cards.

Scheduling Your Exam:

Please schedule your exam session within three (3) months of receipt of payment.

Rescheduling:

To reschedule you must notify the Testing Office of the Academic Support Center at least 24 hours prior to your scheduled appointment for the CLEP exam. You may only reschedule once. **If you do not reschedule within the accepted time frame you will lose your \$30 CLEP administration fee.**

Requirements for Exam Day:

Bring two (2) forms of picture ID and **\$77 payment to ETS (Credit Card or Check Only).**

REGISTRATION IS INCOMPLETE UNTIL PAYMENT IS VERIFIED

Check with a Testing Office staff member to have a date and time assigned to you.
