Embark on adventures with visits to the Great Wall, Jin Mao Tower, the Forbidden City and the Museum of the Terra-Cotta Army. Discover centuries of history — and recognize China's growing importance in the modern business world.

ALL STUDENTS

- Trip dates: May 22-30 (This could shift one or two days either way.)
- Both a passport and a visa are required for this trip. The waiting period for passport is four-to-six weeks. A visa may take one-to-two weeks.
- \$95 registration fee to EF Educational Tours is non-refundable.
- Registration and payment for the noncredit TRS 303 sections — the trip portion — may begin now and payment should be made at the cashier's office. Credit and noncredit students register for different sections (see below).
- Anyone under 18 years of age must have an adult chaperone.
- Last day to drop TRS 303 and receive a refund minus the \$95: Oct. 5 subject to EF Standard Cancellation Policy.
- The U.S. Department of State recommends travelers to China purchase travel insurance due to China's quarantine policies for the H1N1 influenza.

CREDIT STUDENTS

- To take this course for credit, register for BPA 296-401 when spring 2010 term registration opens in November.
- Pay regular tuition for a three-credit course
- Last day to drop BPA 296-401 with a full tuition refund: March 18, 2010
- Last day to withdraw from BPA 296-401: April 27, 2010
- Ages 23 and above, register for TRS 303-201 — \$3,498 in fees
- Ages 18-22, register for TRS 303-202 — \$ 3,257 in fees
