## 2020 Student Right-to-Know Disclosure

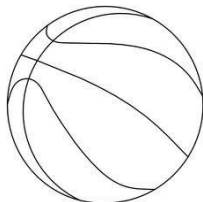
In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, Anne Arundel Community College is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion rates, transfer-out rates, and fall-to-fall retention rates. The graduation and transfer-out rates reported reflect students who either entered the college as full-time, first-time, degree or certificate-seeking undergraduates or were student athletes that received athletically-related financial aid.

While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

- All graduation/completion rates and transfer-out rates are based upon three years of attendance which equates to 150% of the normal completion time of our longest program. Students who died within the three-year period are excluded.
- Students in the cohort may choose to switch to part-time attendance and/or may graduate/transfer-out after three years of attendance.
- In order to protect student privacy, the college is not required to disclose information on any cohort/subcohort with five or fewer students (denoted by "NR").
