### A. Award Eligibility

This scholarship is funded through Maryland Part-time Grant funds and is awarded for \$200 per semester (\$200/fall and \$200/spring) to students who demonstrate financial need and are dually enrolled in high school and AACC. Applications should be submitted only once an academic year.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

- Student must be attending a public or private high school and AACC. Home-schooled students are **not** eligible.
- Student must be a Maryland resident or eligible for in-state tuition at AACC.
- Student must show financial need as determined by the FAFSA.
- Students must enroll part-time (3-11 credits in a semester. Winter and spring semester enrollment is combined and cannot exceed a total of 11 credits between these two semesters.)

### B. Application Process

Check that you have completed **ALL** of the below steps and submit this form to the Financial Aid Office:

- Complete the 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov) using the information from yours and your parents 2019 federal tax returns. Include AACC's school code: 002058.
- Complete an AACC Admissions application online at [www.aacc.edu/apply-and-register](http://www.aacc.edu/apply-and-register) or come to any of our locations to meet with one of our Admissions counselors. **Be sure to include your Social Security number when you apply to AACC so that we will be able to access your FAFSA data.**
- Set-up and monitor your MyAACC email. Once you apply for admission, you will receive an email with information on how to activate your MyAACC account. All communications regarding financial aid from AACC will be sent to your college email address.
