

Guided Pathways for Business Administration Transfer Degree and Business Management

The Strayer courses on the left are all the required courses for Bachelor of Business Administration. The Anne Arundel Community College (AACC) courses are all the courses required to complete an Associate of Science Business Administration Transfer Degree. Any notes indicate recommended AACC courses to best match to the Strayer BBA. Any blanks in the table indicate the remaining courses to be taken at Strayer. Courses in [brackets] indicate that specific course is not required for the AACC degree, but is a recommended elective. Not all courses in brackets are required for the AACC degree; however, Strayer will accept up to 84 semester hours of transfer credits and students may wish to take more than the required courses at AACC. Strayer is on the quarter system and all courses are 4.5 quarter hours. This is equivalent to 3 semester hours.
