

# TRANSFER GUIDE

| B.A. in Psychology

This transfer guide is intended for students pursuing an Associate of Arts in Psychology - Arts and Sciences at Anne Arundel Community College who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology at Goucher College. This transfer guide demonstrates how a student can meet both requirements for the associate degree and prepare for a seamless transfer to Goucher College.

## SAVINGS:

Students can save up to **\$70,176.00** by completing their associate degree at Anne Arundel Community College and then finishing up at Goucher College (based on average costs 2019-20).

## GOUCHER NOTES:

Goucher accepts up to 60 credits from AACC.

Students will need to submit (2) written papers to determine College Writing Proficiency placement ([www.goucher.edu/learn/curriculum/writing-program/information-for-transfer-students](http://www.goucher.edu/learn/curriculum/writing-program/information-for-transfer-students)).

A 3-week study abroad requirement should be completed either January 2021 or summer 2021 (4 credits) for students entering fall 2020.

A 7-week physical activity requirement (0 credit) must be completed if not already fulfilled.
