A.A. in Visual Arts Transfer - Studio Arts

B.F.A. in Art-Graphic Design Track

This transfer guide is intended for students pursuing an Associate of Arts in Visual Arts Transfer - Studio Arts at Anne Arundel Community College who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Art - Graphic Design Track at Salisbury University (program available at main campus and the Universities at Shady Grove campus). This transfer guide demonstrates how a student can meet both requirements for the associate degree and prepare for a seamless transfer to Salisbury University.

SAVINGS:

Anne Arundel County students can save up to \$11,576.00 by first completing their associate degree at Anne Arundel Community College and then transferring to finish up the bachelor degree at Salisbury University (based on 2021-22 undergraduate tuition and fees).

SALISBURY NOTES:

Students need to complete at least 78 hours of ART credits, 16 credits of track courses, 14 credits of ART electives and a minimum of 30 credits of 300/400 level courses.

ART 209 and 210 at AACC satisfy ART 201 at SU. ART 102 subs as ART 261 at SU.
